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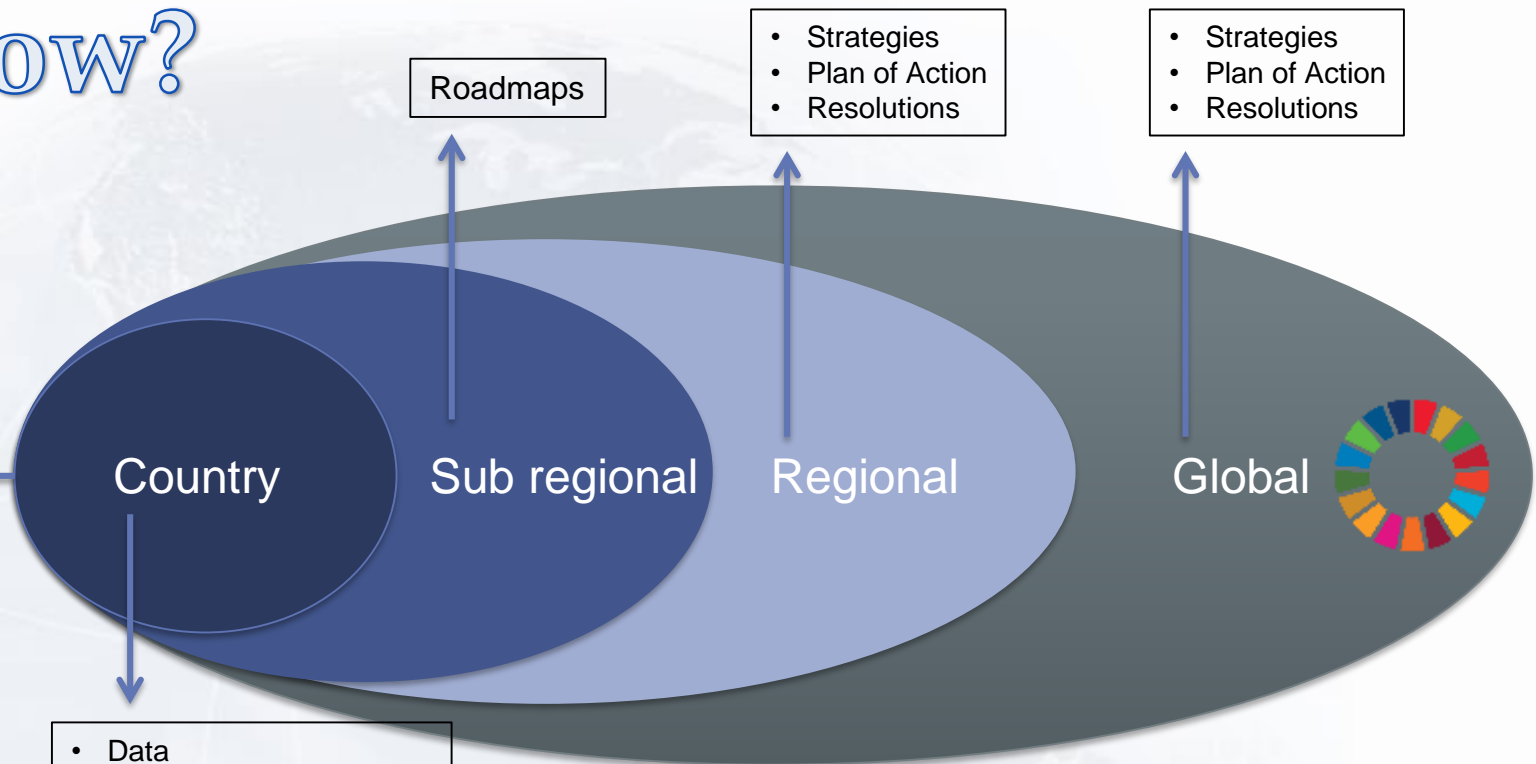

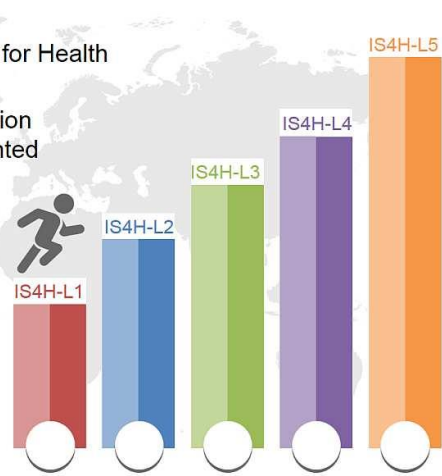

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- **Renewed framework** endorsed by the three Sub regions
 - Caribbean (November 2016, Kingston, Jamaica)
 - Central America (December 2017, Washington, D.C., USA)
 - South America (July 2018, Bogota, Colombia)

- **Standardized tools** created with Countries (*Anguilla, BVI, Jamaica*)
 - IS4H Maturity Assessment tool
 - *Anguilla - BVI – Jamaica – Ecuador – Guyana - Saint Vincent - Suriname - Paraguay*
 - Knowledge Management Methodologies (BVI)

- **Roster of Experts** certified by PAHO

- **On-site** collaboration
 - Anguilla – Bermuda - Bolivia - BVI – Dominica - Ecuador – Guatemala Guyana - Honduras - Jamaica – Suriname – Turk & Caicos



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What's next?

- **PAHO & IDB** supporting countries on maturity assessments and roadmap implementation
- Countries managing **interoperable systems** with **open data** that comes from **different sources** and that is **ethically** used, through **effective ICT tools**, to generate **strategic information** for the benefit of public health
- **Regional Strategy and Plan of Action** on Information Systems for Health endorsed by all Member States (2019)
- Countries implementing **National Roadmaps and Policies** for interoperable systems and informed-decisions mechanisms
- Countries implementing **Digital Literacy** and **Knowledge Sharing Programs** for strengthening IS4H in the Americas
